

## Italian art graces Portomaso's marina

Seven contemporary Italian artists' works are currently on show at the marina of Portomaso, just below the small village of bars, cafés and restaurants.

Organised by MICROarte (Movimento Internazionale Culturale Roma), an organisation which has been active since 2005, the exhibition pays homage to the Italian Futurist artists and to the movement itself.

MICRO, however, are essentially a cultural organisation dealing not only with the visual arts, but also with music, dance, poetry, theatre and cinema. This is not their first time exhibiting in Malta either, as they had already "introduced" themselves to the public with a show of contemporary Italian art some four years ago.

The works vary in theme, genre and medium; however, they are on the most part, large in dimension. Propped up on easels or hung on the colonnade on the inner and outer gazebo-like structure in the marina, the often bold colours and strong compositions of the works inject some much-needed life and colour to the outdoor area.
